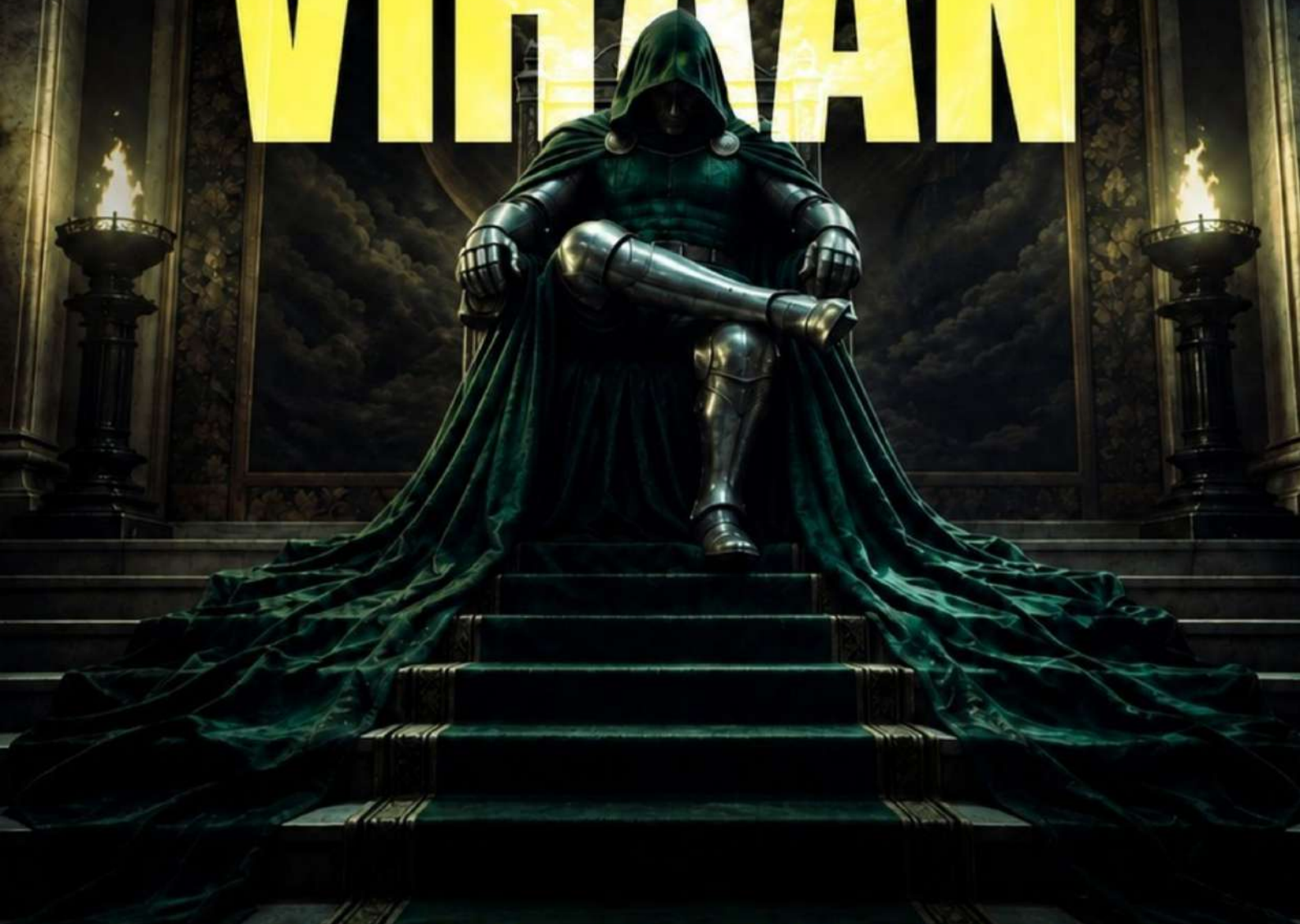

3. GROUP EVENTS ARE TO BE REGISTERED UNDER THE GROUP LEADER'S NAME.
4. ALL MEMBERS OF THE GROUP MUST BE FROM THE SAME COLLEGE, REGARDLESS OF STREAM.
5. SPOT REGISTRATION IF ANY WILL BE INFORMED ON THE DAY OF THE EVENT
6. NO REFUND EITHER FULL OR PARTIAL OF REGISTRATION FEES IN CASE OF NO SHOW BY PARTICIPANTS.
7. ALL STUDENT PARTICIPANTS AS WELL AS NON-PARTICIPANTS MUST COMPULSORILY WEAR THEIR COLLEGE ID CARDS IN THE PREMISES.
